4. Staying Focused on God. Encouraging one another. Praying and reading the word of God. Being still before God amidst all the clamoring from the world. Being still will allow us to hear what God is saying.
5. Simplistic – allowing the Holy Spirit to work in our lives.
6. Keep preserving – press on in our relationship with Christ. Overcoming – an over comer.
 - In/through Jesus Christ. We must confront our fears. Communing with God – examining ourselves.
 - God strengthening us in our weakness – “I can do all things through Jesus Christ. The unity of the saints-there is an Oneness.
 - Tear up the soil in our crying out to God!
7. Come in one accord in unity of our prayers. Get to the root cause of things. The fear of the Lord! We went to the source of what God was saying. The taking of communion during the Watches took me higher – A new person in Christ.

Perfect Order & New Beginnings

8. To God Be the Glory! Oneness – Sensitivity to God. Order is important – Corporate ness. Numbers don't mean a thing-it's the unity of the Spirit. Thankful for the relationships.
